A blend of Inzolia with the international favourite Chardonnay. A dry white with scents of apricot and honey on the nose, yet surprising on the finish with strong exotic fruity overtones.	175ml	<b>3.85</b>	
<b>02 Azabache Young White Rioja</b>	<b>2008</b>	<b>16.70</b>	
Bodegas Aldeanueva, Spain	250ml	<b>5.55</b>

A bouquet of vanilla with an oaky character. Enticing peach, apricot and lemon lead to a fruity mouthful where more tropical flavours add complexity.

Marlborough, New Zealand			
Rich and aromatic, herbaceous and tropical fruit aromas matched by crisp, citrus acidity on the palate and a hint of lychee and limes.

Domaine Gautheron, France			
A very fresh and lively Petit Chablis. It has an aromatic appley nose with plenty of mineral nuances and a fresh steely palate.

Good aromatic intensity and richness of ripe dark vine fruits, blackberries and blackcurrants.
